LEHA CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

Amendments to the LEHA Constitution and Bylaws were approved by the general membership at the recent Annual Business Meeting. The amendments were basically administrative in nature:

Amendment to Article II of the Constitution involved the definitions of Professional Sanitarian and/or Environmental Professional. It also clarified the words active members to mean LEHA members. Article IV addressed the addition of voting privileges for members with Lifetime membership distinction. Article VII added that there must be 7 Board Members present to conduct association business and to be considered a quorum. Article X, regarding dues and membership, stated that membership shall be issued by the Treasure upon payment of dues. The amendment to Article III of the Bylaws stated that the President or designee shall serve as the alternate LEHA representative to the National Environmental Health Association Council of Delegates. It also clarified this would carry over to President-Elect in the event of a vacancy in the Office of President.


